### Parent Survey

Thank you to all those who took part in the recent parent survey. We have reviewed the results and now may share with you some key successes and key ways forward.

#### 2021

First, here are three areas from last year's survey which you told us we need to improve on together with what we've done about these during the year.

- **Some of you did not feel we have high enough expectations for your children**  
We have shared targets for children during parents' days and discussed progress with parents who may have concerns about their child's progress. This is an area we need to continue to work on.
- **Some of you did not feel that we support your child's wider personal development**  
We consulted with you about the Jigsaw programme and shared with you some of the work that is done in the Changing Me part of the programme which looks at
- **Some of you said that we need to be better at letting you know what your child is learning throughout the year.**  
We have been sending out regular newsletters to let you know what is going on in school and have more recently started to share curriculum newsletters with you.

#### 2022

This year, these are three of the things you told us we are doing well:

- My child does well at this school.
- My child feels safe and happy at this school.
- The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

This year, these are the things you would like to see improve:

- **My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.**  
It is important to us that every child is safe in school. In order to address the concerns that some of you have shared we will make sure that any time you share worries about your child being bullied we will communicate very clearly with you what action we are taking to address the issue. We will check back in with your child after the matter has been dealt to ensure there have not been any further issues and take further steps if necessary. We will ensure that we log incidents carefully to help us spot any patterns of behaviour.

Every child matters... every childhood matters.

- **My child has SEND (Special Educational Needs / Disabilities), and the school gives them the support they need to succeed.**

We will ensure that we are meeting with families of children with SEND every term to share their targets, update you on progress and what support is in place.

- **The school has high expectations for my child.**

In our meetings with you we will be clearer about the year group expectations and what we expect from your child.

As a school we are continually wanting to improve, this is why your feedback is so important to us. We will update you on the progress we are making and invite you to give us more feedback at a later date.
