RE: London Royal Opera House Visit for the Magic Flute

We are looking forward to going to London on **Wednesday 25th January**. Below is some information that you may find helpful for the day.

- **6.00 am** meet Mrs Broom and Miss Taylor at the Philip Larkin Statue at Hull Paragon Train station
- **9.14am** arrive at Kings Cross station in London
- **10 am** Explore Covent Garden and toilet stop
- **10.30 am** Early unch
- **11.30 am – 2.35 pm** Performance of 'The Magic Flute'. Ice creams will be provided free of charge
- **3.30 pm** Snacks and toilet stop hopefully at Trafalgar Square (this will depend on weather)
- **3.45 – 5.15 pm** Souvenir shopping and sightseeing around London
- **5.15 - 5.45 pm** Travel back to Kings Cross Station
- **5.45 - 6.30 pm** Tea and toilet stop at Kings Cross Station
- **6.48 pm** Train leaves Kings Cross Station
- **9.25pm** Train is due to arrive at Paragon Station, Hull.

Your child will need to bring the following:

- Sensible, waterproof footwear (not wellington boots)
- Sensible, waterproof coat (hats, scarves and gloves may be sensible, but your child will be responsible for them)
- Food: 2 packed lunches, 2 non-fizzy drinks (there will be a chance to refill with water), snacks for set times during the day
- A named backpack/rucksack to put all of their belongings in
- **No more than £5 spending money** your child will be responsible for this.

Please be aware that anything your child brings, they will need to carry around London for the entire day.

Children are welcome to bring activities for the train such as cards or colouring - please **do not** send anything electronic, including **mobile phones**. We will tweet regularly throughout the day and school will keep in contact about arrival times through the usual text service.
