Parents Day

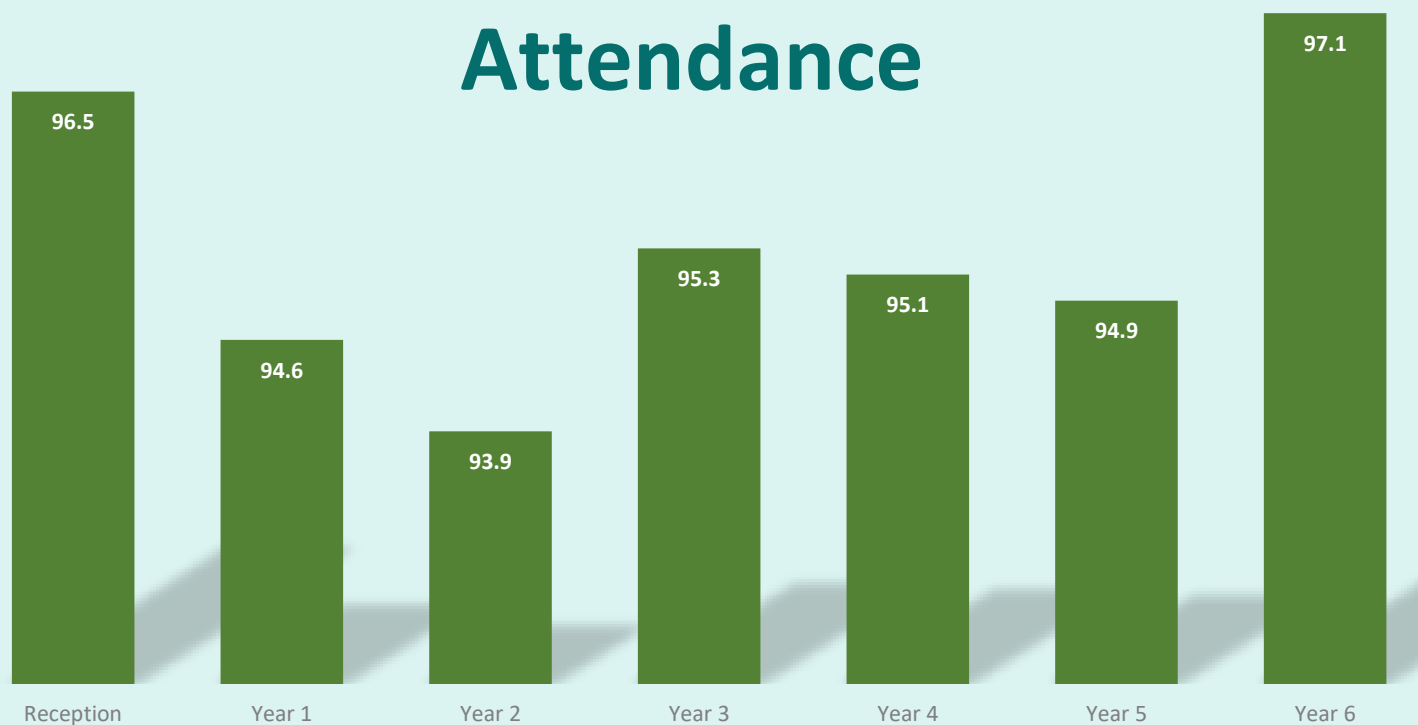
We are holding our Spring Parents day on Wednesday 5th March. You will have the option of either a face to face meeting with your child's teacher or a telephone conversation. All face to face meetings will take place after school between 3:20 and 5:30pm. All telephone appointments will take place during the school day from 8am-3pm.

This year you will be able to choose your own appointment times from those available for the teachers you need to see. You will do this through the Arbor app. Appointment slots will available from 4pm on Friday 14th February.

These are under Guardian Consultations – you will have two per child, you only need to choose one per child – either a face-to-face meeting between 15:20-17:30 or a telephone call between 8am and 3pm.
