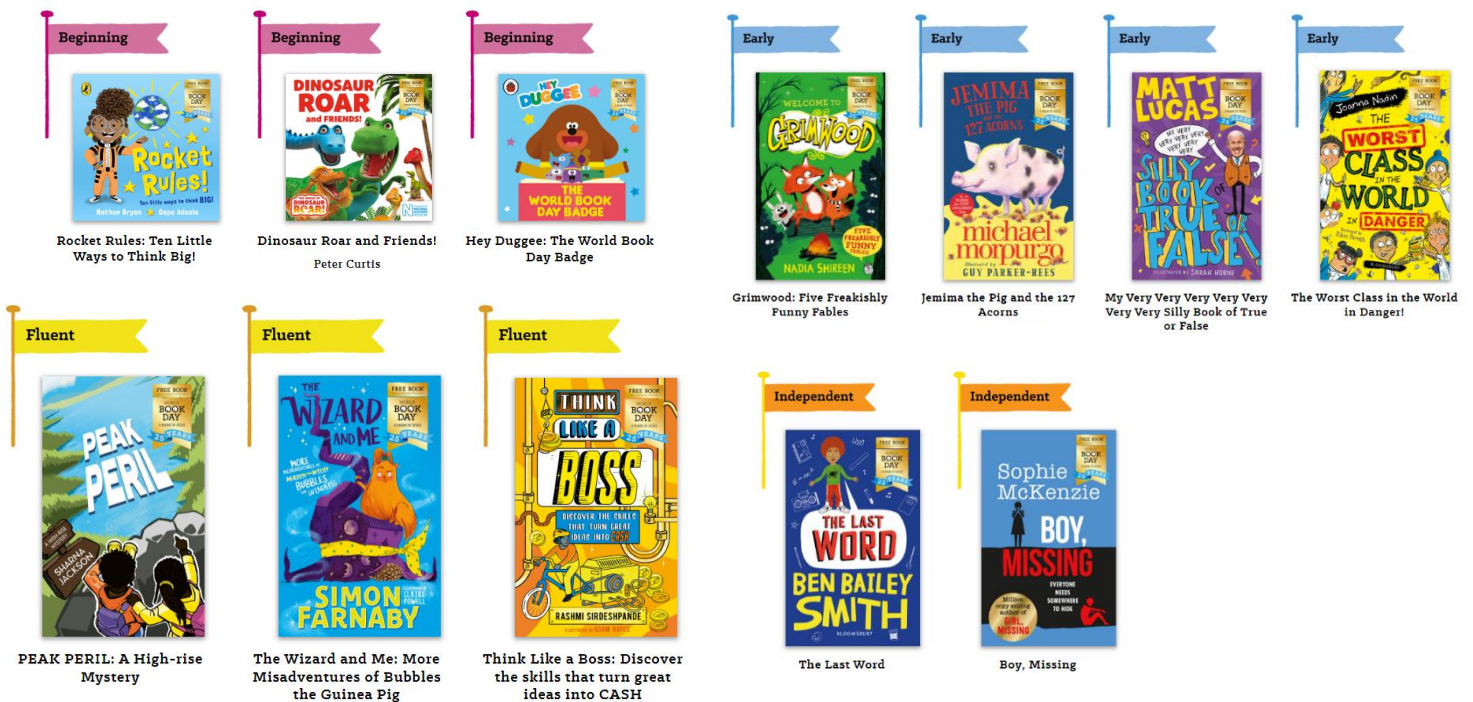


Thank you all for your support today, it has been great to see the children dressed as their favourite book characters and their own creations are so imaginative and inspiring.
