



Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter – Autumn 2

As **writers** we will be looking at image poetry and writing our own alternative stories inspired by *Revolting Rhymes* by Roald Dahl. We will also be developing our understanding of different sentences types – questions, exclamations, statements and commands.

As **readers** we will make predictions, clarify words we do not understand and summarise stories. We will continue to read our books at home and school, these books will be closely linked to our phonics level. Our class text will be *George's Marvellous Medicine* by Roald Dahl.

As **mathematicians** we will be learning to fluently add and subtract within 10. We will then add and subtract two-digit numbers. We will then introduce some multiplication.

As **scientists** we will be looking at Living Things and their Habitats. We will be visiting West Park to link geography, science and design technology.

As **geographers** we will be looking at our local area of Hull. We will be looking at human and physical features.

In **RE** we will looking at how we know right from wrong. We will start to explore Big Questions - what are the bare necessities; why might bad things happen?

As **musicians** we will be learning to listen with attention to detail and recall sounds with increasing accuracy.

In **PE** we will be working on improving our physical skills. We will be mastering basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching with our coach Gareth.

As **dancers** we will be performing dances using simple movement patterns and getting ready to perform on stage with NAPA.

As **gymnasts** we will learning to balance, improve agility and co-ordination.

In **Jigsaw** we will be 'Celebrating Differences' we will be able to tell you some ways we are different from our friends and understand these differences make us all special and unique.

In **design technology** we will be investigating, designing and making our own boats.
